Do you want to handle tension and conflict with more ease?


Do you want to come to decisions with 100% buy-in?

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisites for this course. The course follows its participants and the method itself is applied for participant driven learning. The order of the courses is fixed, from level 1 to 4. Experience with groups (in private and professional context) is helpful.

Time investment
